TOGETHER WE CAN DESIGN A BETTER FUTURE! That's the way everything started: In cooperation with the Nepalese partner organization "Forum for the Welfare of Himalayan Children" (FWHC), the "Freundeskreis Nepalhilfe e. V." (FNH) founded the children's project in 1995. In the children's village, some 100 children – orphans, semi-orphans, children from the streets and children of extremely poor families – have found a home until the end of their vocational training.

#### Care and education



Children of any caste and religion will find their place in our children's village. In four houses, eight housemothers and some ten more staff members take care of them. Our experienced team gives them warmth, love, security, medical care and good education.

We let the children grow up in their own culture and enable them to integrate into a social life outside the children's village.

- Visit our children's village and get into personal contact and friendship with our children.
- Become a sponsor of the children's village and fix your monthly contribution all on your own. With just 35 €, you can guarantee a child's life in the children's village for a month.

#### Education / vocational training

Since May 2012, we have our own primary school in the children's village. In small classes with especially trained teachers, we are now able to care for children with learning deficiencies. From the 5th to the 8th grade, our pupils attend the nearby state "Shree Shanta Higher Secondary School". It was built together with the Federal Ministry for Cooperation and Development (BMZ) and opened in May 2002. In a special program informing about different professional fields, we offer our children as of grade 6 to enlarge their future perspectives.

Our young students of grades 9 and 10 live in the youth hostel in Kathmandu which was built in 2007. There they can assume more responsibility for themselves and they practice acting on their own initiative. In our training workshop, they train technical basic knowledge and find out about their personal skills.

#### Health and environmental protection

Another aim of our charity is the fact to create a conscience for health and environmental protection in the Nepalese society. In the children's village this happens through programs for different age-structures. When terminating the tenth grade, the young people realize a small project (e.g. building toilets, smoke-free ovens) in their home village.

Our charity supports technical projects in rural regions in order to improve the quality of life of their inhabitants sustainable. We achieve that goal e.g. by building health posts, toilets and water plants for the power supply.

In emergency situations like the serious earthquake in spring 2015, we help with life-improving activities and with the re-construction.
